Now that I am a Chamber member, how do I get involved?

Annual Banquet is our annual awards banquet that is held in February of each year. In the past years, the attendance for this banquet has averaged 300 guests.

Golf Classic Tournament is held at a local golf club in the spring of each year. Over the past three years our Golf Classic has averaged over 140 golfers. The 2007 Golf Classic was our most successful tournament with 100% sponsorships sold and 100% player spots sold.

Flower Mound Chamber Bowling Tournament is a great excuse to get out of the office on a Friday afternoon and network with other Chamber members. There is no bowling experience necessary so, come and have some fun, and enjoy music and munchies. Look for this event every summer.

Fiesta Flower Mound is our biggest event of the year. It is a community Party with Live and Silent Auctions held at the Texas Motor Speedway. Last year's event was our most successful Fiesta ever, with "sold out" attendance of over 750 local citizens and Chamber members.

Workshops/Seminars Every year we offer at least two seminars or workshops to assist our members in different aspects of their business, like marketing, human resources and motivation. The topics will be determined by surveys and availability of presenters.

Flower Mound's Spirit of Excellence Luncheon is for the largest employers in Flower Mound and our Flower Mound Chamber Major Investors. These companies have the opportunity to honor their employees of the year and network with other community minded businesses.

Leadership Flower Mound is a nine-month program that begins in September with a team-building course at nearby Stoney Ranch and ends in May with a graduation of the participants. Examples of classes include: The History of Flower Mound, Education, Community Service, Town, County and State Government. The class meets each month on the second Tuesday from 10:00 – 4:00 p.m. Cost is \$575.
